**Mark Walton** is a highly respected and popular figure in the Australian and New Zealand musical scene and is widely acknowledged as a leading clarinet and saxophone performer, inspiring teacher and charismatic musician.

After nearly 20 years as Chair of Woodwind and then Chair of Performance at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, Mark now shares his time, musical talents and energy between Australian and New Zealand.

As Director of Outreach Music he develops community music programmes in regional and rural Australia and New Zealand, and is the Artistic Advisor to the Christchurch School of Music in new Zealand.

Mark is also regarded as a leading authority and pioneer in Distance Instrumental music Education and has led several groundbreaking international projects in this area.

Mark now spends all his spare time composing and has written a large number of works that include three highly successful children's musicals. He has written, compiled or edited over two hundred music publications for different publishers, many of which have become standard woodwind teaching repertoire.

In 2005 Mark was awarded the Order of Australia for his contribution to music education in Australia, and in particular for nurturing talent in rural areas.
